ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT

At a legally called meeting, called for the purpose, of the Congregational Church of Temple, held at Temple, New Hampshire on the third day of February, 1966, it was voted by a unanimous vote that the said Church should become incorporated, retaining its historical continuity, and that the undersigned should be authorized, in behalf of the church to execute articles of agreement for such incorporation, and file the same in the offices of the Town Clerk and Secretary of State.

I.

In accordance with that vote, we, the undersigned, being members of said Church and persons of lawful age, by these articles of agreement hereby associate ourselves together as the representatives of said Church for the purpose of forming a corporation under Chapter 292 of the Revised Statutes Annotated of the State of New Hampshire.

II.

The name of this corporation shall be the Congregational Church of Temple.

III.

The objects for which this corporation is established shall be to continue the historical Church in corporate form, the maintenance of public worship of God in the Town of Temple, and the promotion of Christian knowledge and charity throughout the world, in accordance with the principles and practices of the Congregational-Christian Churches of the State and Nation.

IV.

The meeting of the undersigned for organization of the corporation shall be held at such time and place in Temple, New Hampshire, as shall be designated by the first signer hereof in writing directed by post-office to each of the other signers one week prior to the date set for the meeting.
